## 2. Review and Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes:

The minutes from the 24 February 2021 meeting were reviewed and approved.

- Building & Subdivision Plan Reviews:
- -Peter and Paul: Both plots at the Reedman Property were approved.

Zoning changed back to 2017 to include an industrial warehouse: less traffic, less employees.

North of Rt 213 (Reedman Property) to be used for Amazon parking was approved. Were asked to leave a buffer for residents. Impervious coverage was a concern causing negative impacts. A letter was sent by EAC stating concerns.

-Cornerstone Tracy (23-acre residential development/ two phase development) was addressed.

Low impact development. Steep slope areas were concerning.

In June 2020 the EAC sent a letter of concern regarding environmental impact. Letter from developer was sent back addressing the concerns. Steep slopes would be addressed.

Recommended trees that were diseased or stressed would be replaced after a review by a certified arborist.

Soil erosion and sediment details were also addressed.

Storm water management was also addressed. Much more pervious surface will be added to this area.

Roof drainage was addressed and details were given in the response.

Pedestrian and bicycle routes will be addressed to traffic committee.

Kevin suggested charging stations in new development. Peter suggested recharging station bonuses.

Paul suggested adding that in the letter to PPD.

-West side of Middletown near St Mary's Hospital. Pennswood Village (82 acre senior living facility).

12 acres are to be used to build more residential units. An addition to the common building would be added. No flood plain impact. Future parking in question. Peter will send a letter.
